

Professor Qingshan Zheng

Qingshan Zheng is a professor at Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, and is chairman of Professional Committee of Pharmacometrics of Chinese Pharmacological Society affiliated to Chinese Pharmacological Society. He has been working in academic institutes and hospitals in the field of pharmacometrics and biostatistics, where his primary role is to lead a team of clinical pharmacologists in China to support the development and registration of both small and large molecules for a range of indications. The team use mathematical modeling and simulation to conduct non-clinical to clinical translation of pharmacology and safety, understand disease progression and dose-response properties, optimize the design and dosing regimen of clinical trials, and rationalize dosing recommendations in new drug marketing applications and drug labels.



With over 20 years of the experience, he is a member of several review and governance committees in R&D, where he contributes to ensuring cutting-edge sciences and methodologies are deployed to enhance the efficiency of development programs and the rigour of registration packages. The combination of his team leadership role and senior panel memberships gives him both a deep scientific insight in clinical pharmacology discipline and a broad view on drug development and registration needs.
