### Prof. Yusuke Tanigawara

Prof. Yusuke Tanigawara is Professor of Clinical Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics, Keio University School of Medicine, Tokyo, Japan. He has been studying the pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics (PK/PD) for 40 years. His research interests include pharmacometric analysis (modeling and simulation) mainly in oncology, infectious diseases and osteoporosis, and its application to new drug development as well as rational use of medicine for patient care. He also investigates multi-omics biomarkers for drug response (pharmacogenomics, proteomics and metabolomics) applicable to personalized medicine.



Currently, he serves Secretary of International Society of Pharmacometrics (ISoP), Executive Board member of World Conference on Pharmacometrics (WCoP), President of the Population Approach Group in Japan, and President-Elect of the International Association of Therapeutic Drug Monitoring and Clinical Toxicology (IATDMCT).
